

2010 Application for the IWLL Conservation Scholarship

This scholarship is funded in the amount of \$1,000.00 for the school term starting in September of 2010. It is designed to assist a graduating high school student from the Amherst, Nelson, Campbell, Bedford County, Lynchburg City school systems as well as private and home schooled students in these areas. Eligible students must have been accepted in an accredited college program in the field of conservation and maintained a minimum high school grade point average of 3.0. Some examples of eligible fields of study include, but are not limited to, Forestry and Wildlife, Wildlife Management, Veterinary Medicine, Game Biology, Environmental Engineering, Marine Biology and Earth Sciences.

An applicant for this scholarship has to provide proof of acceptance to an accredited college for the 2010-2011 school year in one of the above fields of study. The applicant must also submit a 300 word essay that outlines how they plan to use their educational experience to further the goals of the Izaak Walton League of America which are outlined in the member's pledge which the worthy student will research for themselves. Applications must be postmarked prior to July 10, 2010.
