

## “Range Safety Committee:

Consists of the Club President, Park Caretaker, Match Directors, and other additional Range Qualified members named as Range Safety Officers and appointed on an annual basis by the Club President. Range Safety Committee members/contact numbers will be posted on the Ranges. A minimum of 3 Range Safety Committee members will meet after regularly scheduled meetings(or special meeting called by the Club President) for any required suspension hearings. “

“All Range Members are responsible for enforcing the rules. Any violations should be promptly reported to the Park Caretaker or a member of the Range Safety Committee. Any unsafe action is considered a rule violation and subjects the offender to immediate removal from the Range and subsequent discipline by the Range Committee. “

“Decisions of the Range Safety Officers/Match Directors must be complied with promptly, but subsequent appeal may be made to the Range Safety Committee by request to the Club President.”

**NOTE: A Range Safety Officer(or any other Range Qualified member) may ask to see your Range Card at any time. Range Safety Officers may retain your card and suspend your Range privileges if they ascertain that you are in violation of R & P rules. You must then request and appear before a Range Safety Committee meeting in order to protest your loss of Range privileges.**

“Unauthorized persons found using the Ranges will be treated as trespassers and prosecuted as such. Range Members whose range privileges are suspended are considered unauthorized persons for the duration of their suspension.”
