CAMPING RULES

The campers have a yearly election where they appoint a Camping Committee to assist along with the Park Supervisor and the Board of Directors in overseeing the camping area. The committee consists of a chairman, co-chairman and a treasurer. Special elections may be held with 2 weeks notice to all campers in the event one or more of the Camping Committee officer positions need to be replaced. In order to be eligible to be on the Camping Committee, you must camp at least two(2) weekends or two(2) nights each or four(4) separate nights during the camping season.

1. Camping privileges are limited to Izaak Walton League Members and immediate families. Visiting Izaak Walton League members may use the camping facilities on an availability basis and are subject to all camping rules.
2. Any camper who owes camping fees from a previous visit or previous year must pay in full before they will be allowed to put camping equipment on a site: no exceptions. They must also be a current park member (**no exceptions**).
3. IMMEDIATELY: Upon arrival, member should select a campsite, register and deposit appropriate fees (see Price Insert sheet) in the provided collection box. If you intend to camp for more than one night or if you plan to leave your equipment unattended on the site for one or more nights, you **MUST** pay the total fees in advance.

If you prefer to pay on a day-to-day basis while camping, your fees must be voluntarily deposited prior to 6 PM each day. Monthly payments are due by the 5th day of the month.

Any member that reaches two (2) months delinquency in payment of their camping fees shall be allowed fifteen (15) days to bring all fees current. Should this not occur, their membership will be suspended for the remaining calendar year and they will be directed to remove RV and all personal belongings from park property immediately. A second like violation will result in membership being revoked permanently. A member may pay monthly or yearly in advance, however, there will be no refund for any unused portion. If park fees are adjusted during the prepaid period, members are liable for the increase.

4. For a member leaving camping equipment at the Park during the off season October 1 through April 30, the fee is listed on the Price Insert sheet. The Board of Directors will define the storage area for camping equipment. A liability waiver form must be signed by Park member before storage services will be provided.

5. A member or their spouse may acquire a site by appearing in person, selecting a site, registering, paying the appropriate fees and placing their equipment on the site.

This site will be considered occupied for a period of 24 hours if one night's fee is deposited in the box at time of placing sign on site.

6. Campers may leave and put up a sign as to date leaving and return date to reserve a *paid-up* site.
7. Only one (1) tent, trailer, motor home or camping van is allowed on a campsite unless authorized by a Camping Committee Member, Park Supervisor or Board of Directors. Screen houses and additional tents fall within the realm of these extras that will have to be approved by the above. No fences or lattice work can be put around the campsite or trailer without prior authorization of the Board.
8. There will be no more than two (2) vehicles on any site if room allows for two. Additional vehicles, including those belonging to visitors, must be parked in the General Park parking area. No vehicle may be parked on the road at or near the Campsite or at any unoccupied sites.

PLEASE NOTE:

9. GARBAGE OR TRASH CANS ARE TO BE USED WITH LINERS. LINERS MAY BE SECURED FROM ANY CAMPING COMMITTEE MEMBER OR PARK EMPLOYEE. CAMPING MEMBERS ARE RESPONSIBLE FOR DEPOSITING THE FILLED TRASH BAGS IN THE DUMPSTER (located in General Park parking area). Garbage or trash will not be burned in the camping area. BEFORE LEAVING THE PARK ALL GARBAGE MUST BE TAKEN TO THE DUMPSTER OR BE REMOVED FROM RHE PARK.
10. State law requires that all sink or shower water be collected in an enclosed container. There are two places available for dumping sink or shower water – one at the rear of the bath house and one is at the side of the tool house located in Loop A. A sewer dump station is located in Loop B. Rubber rings (donuts) must be used on all sewer hoses.
11. Only fallen trees may be cut for firewood. Under no circumstances is a member, his family or guest to cut, deface or in any manner destroy Park trees or shrubbery.
12. NOTE: camping courtesy is a must. Quiet should be observed between the hours of 11 PM and 7 AM Sunday through Friday and at 12 midnight Saturday until 7 AM Sunday. No roaming on roads or in General Park area after quiet hour.

13. The Camping Committee, Park Supervisor and Board of Directors are all authorized to interpret and enforce the camping rules. ANY MEMBER MAY PROTEST A CAMPING RULE INTERPRETATION TO THE BOARD.
14. The seasonal camping members are expected to assist in work details and camping projects which will be coordinated by the Camping Committee, Park Supervisor or Board of Directors. **Campers are also expected to keep grass cut on their site.** Mowers are available at the tool house. Plants/etc. not in portable containers may be removed by the Park at any time.
15. Converted school buses, park models or mobile homes are not allowed in the campground. Homemade Campers that are not equipped with lights and appliances normally found in a factory manufactured unit are also not allowed in the campground.
16. A size limit for campers will be enforced. See Price Insert sheet for a list of lots and maximum trailer size for each.
Campers on 30 amp sites must use the appropriate adapter

17. Expenditures must be approved by the Board of Directors.
18. Camping by any individual IWLL member will be limited to nine consecutive months and no more than nine months total in a calendar year.
19. No pets are to be left unattended. No pets are to be left outdoors overnight.
