August 29 – Silhouette Shooting (Pistol Range, 3:00 p.m. – Tom Graves 434-841-9975)

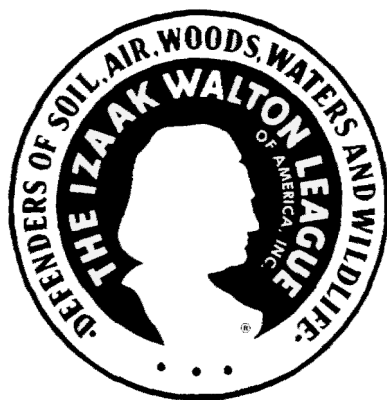
### Want to Become a R&P Member?
